



Developmental Sequence and ages for Writing Skills

- 2-0 Imitates I (vertical line)
- 2-6 Imitates (horizontal line)
- 2-9 Imitates (circle)
- 2-10 Copies I
- 3-0 Copies (horizontal line)
- 3-0 Copies (circle)
- 3-6 Imitates X
- 3-6 Grasp Pencil with thumb, index and middle fingers
- 3-9 Traces and stays on (most of time) 3-inch pencil-thick horizontal line
- 3-11 Begins to copy some vertical & horizontal letters
- 4-1 Copies + (plus)
- 4-5 Grasp Pencil with thumb and fingers instead of fist
- 4-6 Touch tip of thumb to each finger
- 4-6 Grasp pencil with pad of index finger and thumb as pencil rests on third joint of middle finger
- 4-6 Copies □ (square)
- 4-7 Draws line within both horizontal and vertical paths
- 4-10 Traces around own hand with crayon
- 4-10 Draws some simple, recognizable objects
- 5-0 Draws face with mouth, nose, and eyes
- 5-0 Copies first name (letters awkward/reversed)
- 5-9 Cuts well with scissors
- 5-3 Copies Δ (triangle)
- 5-5 Copies first name clearly enough to be read
- 5-7 Prints first name in uppercase or lowercase letters without model
- 6-1 Prints all numerals and letters without copying
